ACT also offered the Explore test for 8th and 9th graders. Explore was also a version of the ACT, but shorter and designed to predict the future success of middle school students. The Plan was scored between 1-32, whereas the ACT is scored between 1-36. It predicted an ACT score between 1 and 5 points higher than the Plan score. Table 1.

Using the Iowa Assessments to Predict ACT Composite Scores

ACT's own predictor test, EXPLORE, and the ACT, which are .75 for English, .73 for Math, .68 for Reading, and .65 for Science (ACT, 2011, EXPLORE Technical Manual, p. 45). Similarly, the Grade 10 correlations are almost identical to those between ACT's PLAN test and the ACT of .80
